### Part 1A: Service Level Progress 'Independent Validation'

under **'Service Level** To validate claimed **Progress'**, assessors with progress citizens/residents/shopkeepers along with on-field checking of physical infrastructure/ICT based interventions. The sample size for each city and negative marking on account of sample failure would be as per population.

### Impact on 'Service Level Progress' Marks claimed

- **Step-1:** % of samples failed will lead to same % of marks deducted from the marks claimed under 'Service Level Progress' = Adjusted Marks
- **Step-2:** Negative Marking: On account of failure of samples from 20% onwards, further negative marking will be applied as per the following table, to calculate 'Final Marks'



No.13 (253)/CIDMIZ0917278.—In pursuance of orders of the Hos The High Court of Delhi in CM No. 220%20017 2 a 2465-2017 in WPC, 9047-2017, 2017-2017, 9047-2017, and WPC, 1964-2017 and UN No. 39355/2017 dated 1909/2017, 15/11/2017 and 05/12/2017 and in searcise of powers conferred under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) and Rule 4(5) of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 read with Notification No. U-11/903/91-1171, dated 1009/1992, the Hors Bet. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby directs the New Delhi Manciepul Council to give effect to the following Byo-Laws for Management of Solid Waste in its prindiction, as farmed by the New Delhi Manciepul Council, in currence of powers under Rule 15 (cf.) 15(1) and 15 (cf.) of the Solid Waste than 25 of the Ravious Council C

### CHAPTER I

### GENERAL

- Short Title and Commencement: (1) These bye-laws shall be called the New Delhi Municipal Council Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws, 2017.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Delhi Gazette
- Applicability: These bye-laws shall be applicable within the territorial limits of New Delhi Municipal Council (hereinafter referred to as 'NDMC').
- 3. Definitions:
  - (1) In these bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires,
  - (a) "Bulk Garden and Horticultural Waste" means bulk waste from parks, gardens etc. including grass clippings, weeds, weedy "brown" carbon-rich material such as pruning, branches, twigs, wood chipping, straw, dead leaves, tree trimmings, etc. which cannot be accommodated in the daily collection system for bio-degradable waste;
  - (b) "Bulk Waste Generator" means bulk waste generator defined under Ruls 31(3) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 (heroinafter referred to as 'SWM Rules') and any other waste generator notified by the Assistant Commissioner or equivalent of the concerned ward office or the officers senior
  - (c) "Collection" means lifting and removal of solid waste from source of waste generation, collection points or any other location:
  - (d) "Competent Authority" means the Chairperson of NDMC or any person authorized by him.
  - (0) "Construction and Demolition waste" shall have the same meaning as defined under Rule 3(1)(c) of the Construction and Demolition Waste Rules, 2016;
  - (f) "Clean Area" means the public place in front of and all around or adjacent to any premises extending to the kerb side and including the drain, foot path and kerb cleaned and so maintained in accordance with these bus larve.
  - (g) "Community Waste Storage Bin (Dhalao)" means any storage facility set up and maintained by NDMC or collectively by owners and/or occupiers of ense or more premises for storage of solid waste in a segregated manner on the roadside/in premises of any one of such owners/occupiers or in their common premises as authorized by the competent authority;









No Solid Waste in Water bodies implies: Waste should not be floating on the surface or banks of the Water Body










