>=15%	100

Methodology: Registration Marks

Formula would be:

$$\text{Registration Marks} = \frac{(\text{Number of Registrations})}{\text{Population of the city}} \times 100$$

Note: The minimum qualification criteria for this 2% of registrations.
* Final Score of this indicator for SS19 will be the calculated as per the table above.


Important Considerations

- ✓ Details of all gated societies/RWAs in the city profile, to be filled-up before assessment starts along with population of these areas. Remaining households shall be considered for computation of households practicing 'Home Composting '




