Release of Rs 180,00,00,000/- as advance to State Governments for preparation of Smart City Proposal (SCP) under Smart Cities Mission (SCM) guidelines.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority for the release of Rs. 180,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Eighty Crore only) as advance to State Governments as per list attached, at the rate of Rs. 2,00,00,000/- per City/Urban Local Body as part of State Funds for Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE) for preparation of Smart City Proposal (SCP) in terms of Para 12.1 of SCM guidelines.

- 2. The amount of advance will come from the city's share of the A&OE funds and will be adjusted in the share of the city at the time of release of first instalment.
- 3. The aforesaid sanction is subject to the following conditions:
 - i) The sanction shall be regulated in accordance with the provisions of GFR, 2005/SCM guidelines.
 - ii) The State Governments would maintain a separate account in respect of SCM.
 - iii) The money will be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned.
 - iv) The State Governments will furnish utilization certificate in respect of funds released at an early date in the prescribed Performa as provided in the SCM guidelines.
- 4. This is the first release to States under SCM guidelines. As such, no Utilisation Certificate is pending in respect of the States mentioned in the sanction order as per requirement.
- 5. The expenditure involved will be debited to the Major Head 3601-Grant-in-aid to State Govts., 04-Other Urban Development Schemes, 315-Assistance to Local Bodies, Corporation, Urban Development Authorities, Town Improvement Board etc., 03-Mission for 100 Smart Cities, 03.00.31-Grants-in-aid General under Grant No. 104-Ministry of Urban Development of the year 2015-16 (Plan).
- 6. The amount of Rs. 180,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Eighty Crore only) may be transferred to State Governments through Reserve Bank of India as per procedure laid down by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide OM No. F-II (45/76/SC) dated 22.02.1977.
- 7. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy. No. 1012/US (D-II)/FD/15 dated 28.08.2015.
- 8. The Sanction has been registered at Sl.No. 1 of the Sanction register of Smart Cities Division (SC-1) for the year 2015-16.
