OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Individual Capacity Building- Empanelment of Training Entities.

According to para 13.2. of the AMRUT guidelines, the key feature of individual capacity building is demand driven periodic training, recognition of practices and functionaries, independent assessment of training outcomes, mentoring and peer networking. Individual capacity building will include the following type of activities.

- i. Strategic training plan based on Training Needs Assessment (TNA).
- ii. Exposure visits.
- iii. Workshops, seminars, research studies and documentation.
- iv. Individual capacity building focusing on coaching and task-related assistance from peers & mentors.
- Visibility, including preparation of Information Education and Communication (IEC) materials.
- Based on the Training Needs Analysis (TNA), the focus will be on (i) Finance & Revenue (ii) 2. Engineering & Public Health (iii) Town Planning and (iv) Administration departments of ULBs. The ULBs will plan to train at least 30 functionaries from the four departments every year and all elected representatives. The elected representatives will be imparted training once at the training institutes, which will include a site-visit to learn from best practices in India. The training will consist of three capsules spread over a year. Each capsule will consist of three days training in the training institute followed by four months during which the training will be applied in their work by the municipal functionaries. During a period of one year, therefore, a municipal functionary will be imparted training for nine (9) days in the training institute.
- The training will be conducted by empanelled Training Entities and the objectivities of the training will be independently assessed by NIUA, which is a strategic partner of the MoUD in Capacity Building. The NIUA will be involved in disseminating information on training module, documenting best practices, monitoring the progress of training, and evaluating the benefits of training after completion of each training capsule.
- 4. Accordingly, MoUD has shortlisted a panel of Training Entities for rolling out individual capacity building for ULB functionaries on the above mentioned activities and the subject-wise list of short listed Training Entities is enclosed. The States/UTs may draw upon the Panel as per extant rules and start imparting training at the earliest. A copy of the contract to be signed with Training Entities may be sent to the MoUD for funding through CBUD.
